

COLLEGE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

58 random universities and colleges were chosen for the information given.

GPA: 37 out of 58 schools do not have a minimum GPA for admission

Lowest GPA Requirement: 2.0 (Idaho State University, Lewis-Clark State College, University of Washington)

Highest GPA Requirement: 3.6 (Stanford University)

SAT Scores: 37 out of 58 schools do not have a minimum SAT score required for admission

Lowest SAT Score Requirement: 690 (Lewis-Clark State College)

Highest SAT Score Requirement: 1300 (Texas A&M University)

ACT Scores: 37 out of 58 schools do not have a minimum ACT score required for admission

Lowest ACT Score Requirement: 17 (Lewis-Clark State College)

Highest ACT Score Requirement: 30 (Texas A&M University)

High School Rank: 20 out of 58 schools use HSR as an admissions qualification

Highest HSR Requirement: Top 25% of class or 1st Quarter (Arizona State University & University of Oklahoma)

Other Common Requirements: Grade trends over the four years, leadership positions, community service/volunteer involvement, rigor and difficulty of courses taken (**honors courses**), and letters of recommendation from teachers

Most Common Requirement: Grade trends over the four years in high school

Most Uncommon Requirement: Relationships with classmates (Yale College)

General Analysis: The information taken from the 58 universities has shown that universities and colleges use many factors in admitting students. GPA and standardized test scores are just a few of the many requirements that are observed. A student with a high GPA and average SAT/ACT scores may not necessarily be admitted if they exhibit poor grade trends, absence of honors courses, and a lack of community service. On the other hand, a student with a poor GPA may be a candidate for admittance if they have numerous honors courses, consistent grade trends, and has held leadership positions throughout their high school career. In other words, most universities and colleges are using a holistic approach to admitting students into their schools.
