THANK YOU FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE COMPASS PARENT SURVEY. WE HAD 206 SURVEY RESPONSES. THE RESULTS ARE FAVORABLE, ALTHOUGH, THERE IS ALWAYS ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT.

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND I WILL FURTHER EXAMINE THE INDIVIDUAL COMMENTS AND TAKE REASONABLE AND CONSTRUCTIVE RECOMMENDATIONS IN TO CONSIDERATION. BASED ON INITIAL REVIEW OF THE COMMENTS, I WOULD LIKE TO MAKE SOME RECOMMENDATIONS OF MY OWN:

- SPEND SOME TIME IN YOUR CHILDREN’S CLASSROOMS. THIS IS THE ONLY WAY TO REALLY UNDERSTAND THE INSTRUCTIONAL METHOD AND GET A FEEL FOR THE SCHOOL’S “CULTURE.”
- USE THE PARENT FEEDBACK FORM AVAILABLE ON THE WEBSITE AND IN THE SCHOOL OFFICE TO ADDRESS CONCERNS. PROBLEM SOLVING IS THE ONLY EFFECTIVE METHOD FOR RESOLVING ISSUES.
- COMMUNICATION IS EVERYONE’S RESPONSIBILITY. EMAIL ADDRESSES FOR TEACHERS, BOARD MEMBERS AND MYSELF ARE ALL AVAILABLE ON THE SCHOOL WEBSITE. FEEL FREE TO INITIATE COMMUNICATION AT ANY TIME. WAYS IN WHICH THE SCHOOL CURRENTLY COMMUNICATES WITH PARENTS INCLUDE: WEEKLY FRIDAY ATTENDANCE LETTER, MONTHLY PFA NEWSLETTER, WEBSITE, CORRECTED/RETURNED STUDENT SCHOOL WORK, MONTHLY OPEN BOARD MEETINGS, PHONE CALLS, QUARTERLY REPORT CARDS, STUDENT LED AND PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES, AND TEACHER LETTERS/NOTES HOME.

THE COMPASS STAFF IS HERE TO SERVE YOUR CHILDREN’S EDUCATIONAL NEEDS. WE WILL CONTINUE TO STRIVE TO DO THAT JOB BETTER. WE ARE ALWAYS OPEN TO PARENT’S INVOLVEMENT AND SUGGESTIONS ON WAYS TO IMPROVE COMMUNICATION.
