Extra Hall of Fame

Warhawk Air Museum

Our class is scheduled to take a trip to the Warhawk Air Museum on Wed., December 10th from 9:00 to 1:00. We need parents to lead small groups of students, so please let me know if you are able to come. Thanks!

Cost

Students need to bring \$4 for the admission fee for the museum. If you want to send \$5, the extra dollar would be used to pay admission for any students whose families need help with the fee.

Field Trip Objectives

In Number the Stars, the novel we are reading, the author describes the life of a Danish family after the Germans take control of Denmark. The presentation at the Warhawk Air Museum teaches students about the lives of American children during World War II. In addition, the students have the opportunity to look through the exhibits in the museum, most of which were given to the museum for dis-

play by men and women in the Treasure Valley who took part in the war or had family members who did. From the exhibits, students can also learn what life was like for Americans during the war.

Direct Writing Assessment (DWA)

Please note that fifth graders will take this state writing test on Wednesday, December 3rd. Students are asked to write a narrative essay on an assigned topic. No make up tests are permitted, so it is very important for students to attend school on that day.
