Skill Builder Mad Minutes:

Practice facts incrementally in order to make it easier to pass the Hall of Fame Multiplication and Division Mad Minutes for a plaque:

Multiplication Levels A, B, C
Division Levels A, B, C

Directions for Mad Minute Practice at Home:

Each student begins in either multiplication or division at a level intended to help that individual pass quickly and move to the next level.

1. Do a one-minute practice of the assigned Mad Minute with the goal of increasing the number finished each day.
2. Complete the unfinished problems in that assigned Mad Minute.
3. Complete one page of the Mad Minute at the next level above, un-timed, until both Multiplication and Division have been passed in class.

Once Multiplication and Division have been passed, choose two Mad Minutes to practice each night working toward earning a plaque. For lengthy Mad Minutes, such as U.S. Map and States & Capitals, only one Mad Minute is required for homework.

Important Notes:

- Multiplication and Division are required on Friday Hall of Fames until passed.
- Only math Mad Minutes are timed because they require a score of 50 or greater in one minute in order to pass.
- There are three different tests to pass for States and Capitals.
- An alphabetized spelling list accompanies the States and Capitals test. This list may not be taken home, but the States and Capitals song may be used for spelling help at home because it is important for students to learn to spell these names correctly.
